

LGAP NOW!

A support program for the implementation of the Livestock Global Assurance Program (LGAP)

What is LGAP Now!?

- LGAP Now! is a project that will provide cost and onboarding support to allow exporters and their supply chains to gain first-hand experience of LGAP.
- The project aims to build interest and understanding of LGAP and help identify challenges, opportunities, and essential considerations to enable the efficient and effective support of LGAP implementation across all markets.
- Facilities (feedlots and abattoirs) and Operators (exporters and importers) will be able to trial LGAP and will receive support from the LEP team in market.
- Participants will gain first-hand experience with the AniMark IT Conformance System, the LGAP on-boarding process and access to dedicated coaching.
- Following the release of an Export Advisory Notice, the LGAP audit report can also be used by exporters to assist with their compliance obligations under ESCAS.

What will LGAP Now! pay for?

- The cost of the first audit (including travel and expenses) which must be completed before 30 June 2021 (subject to availability).
- 50% of the costs of up to THREE additional audits*
- *To be eligible for the additional audits the Operator or Facility must meet the remaining 50% of the costs, the audits must be conducted within a 12-month period of the first audit and the Operator or Facility *must maintain LGAP certification*. Ongoing audit frequency is driven by facility risk rating as outlined in the table below.
- The LGAP application fee and initial membership fee (for exporters this applies to the provisional membership fee only).

Low Risk	Medium Risk	High Risk
1 audit every 12 months	1 audit every 6 months	1 audit every 3 months

Who is eligible and how to participate?

- Exporters and their supply chain partners who are willing to work with AniMark and the LEP are invited to apply.
- AniMark's launch targets are Indonesia, Vietnam, Kuwait and the United Arab Emirates, but AniMark and the LEP will consider other markets on a case by case basis.
